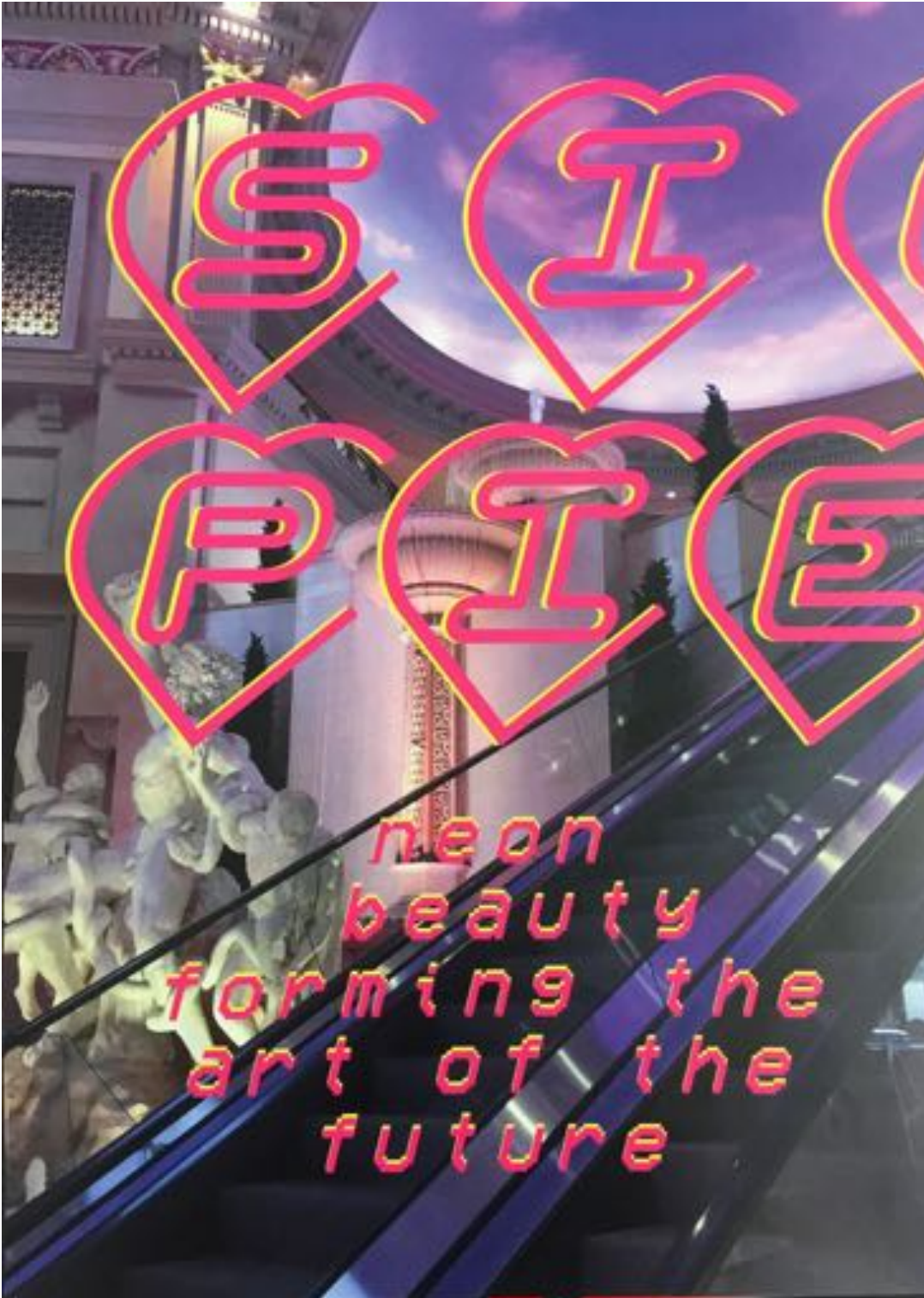

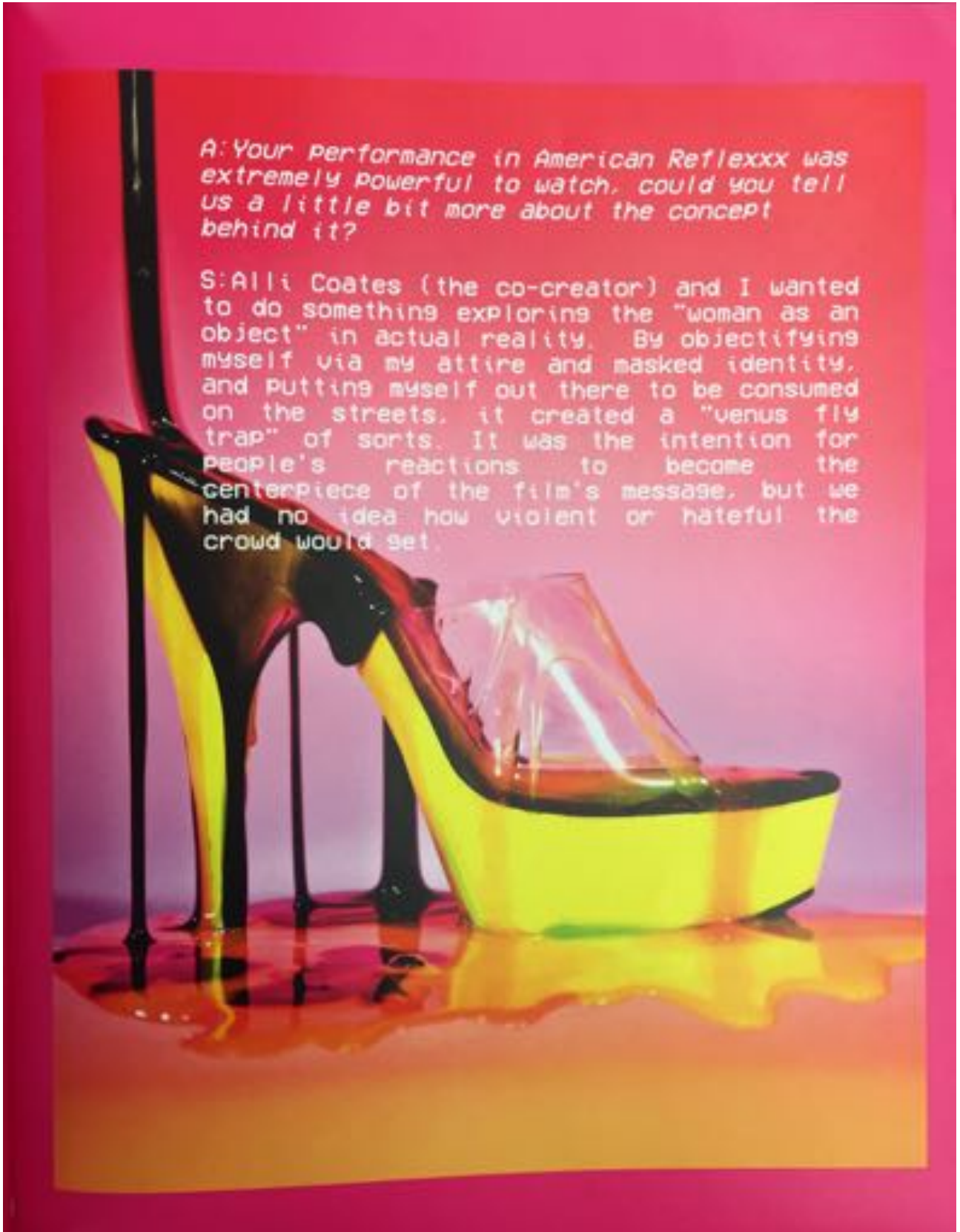
Signe Pierce. Neon Beauty form the art of the future

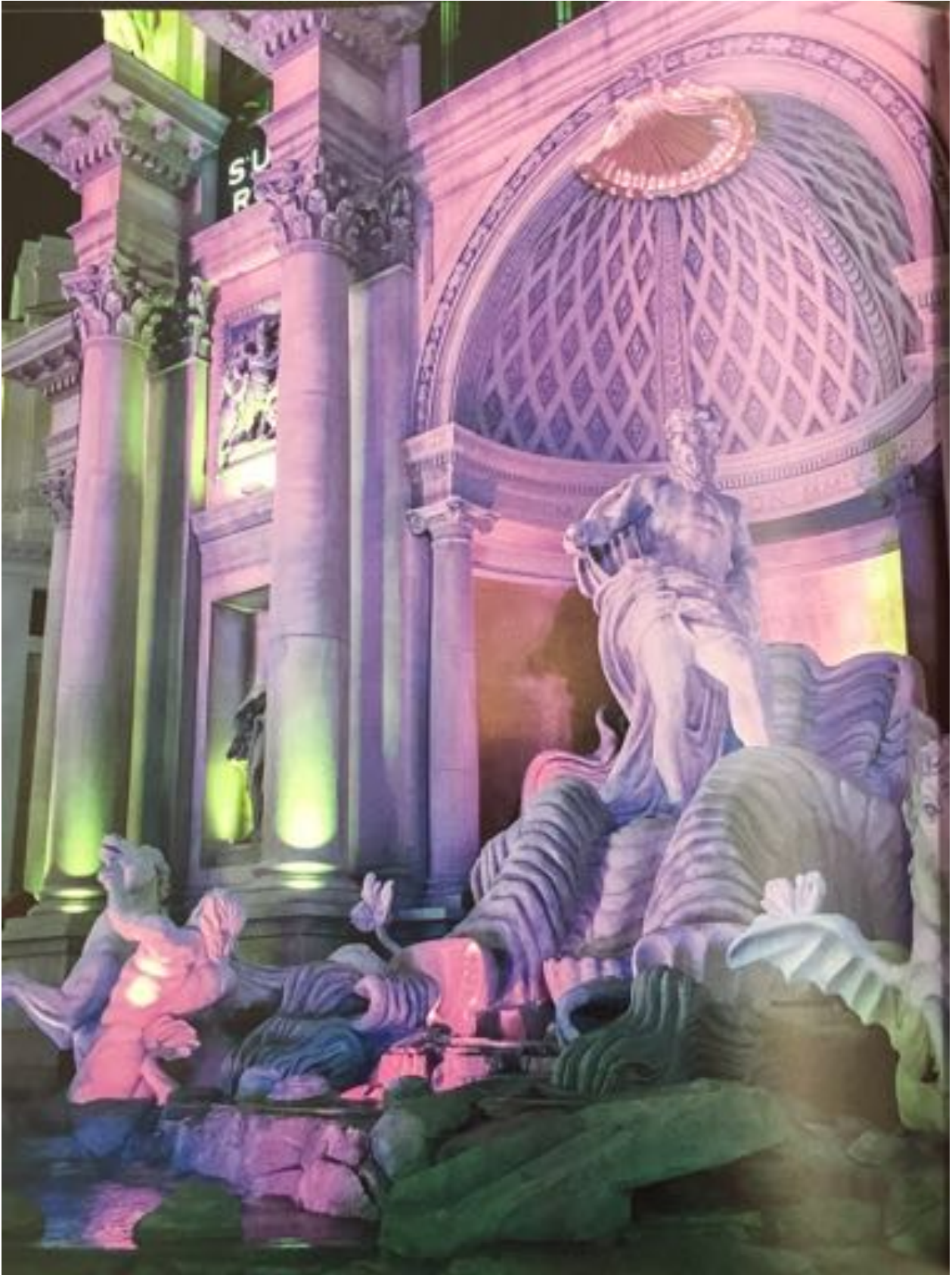


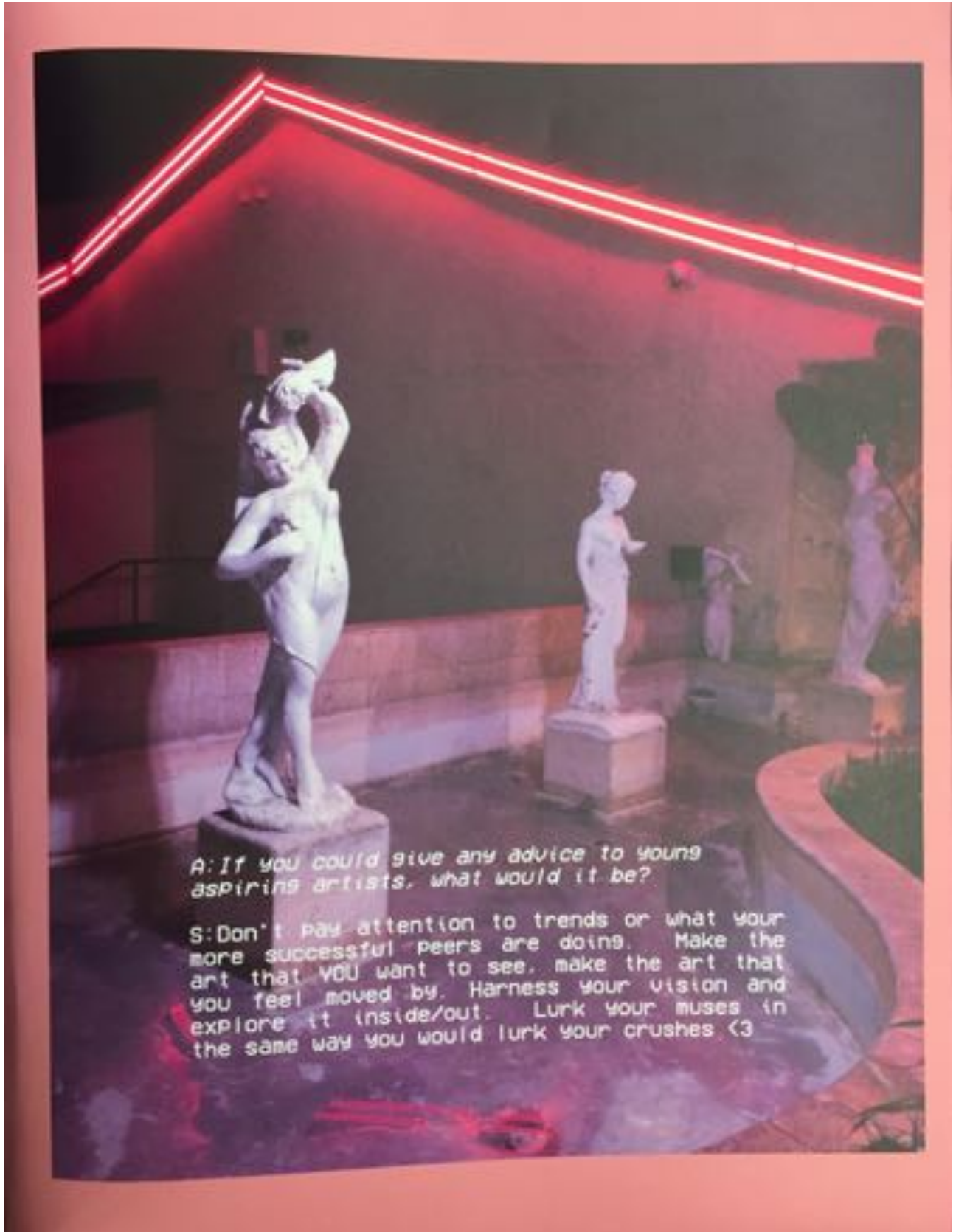


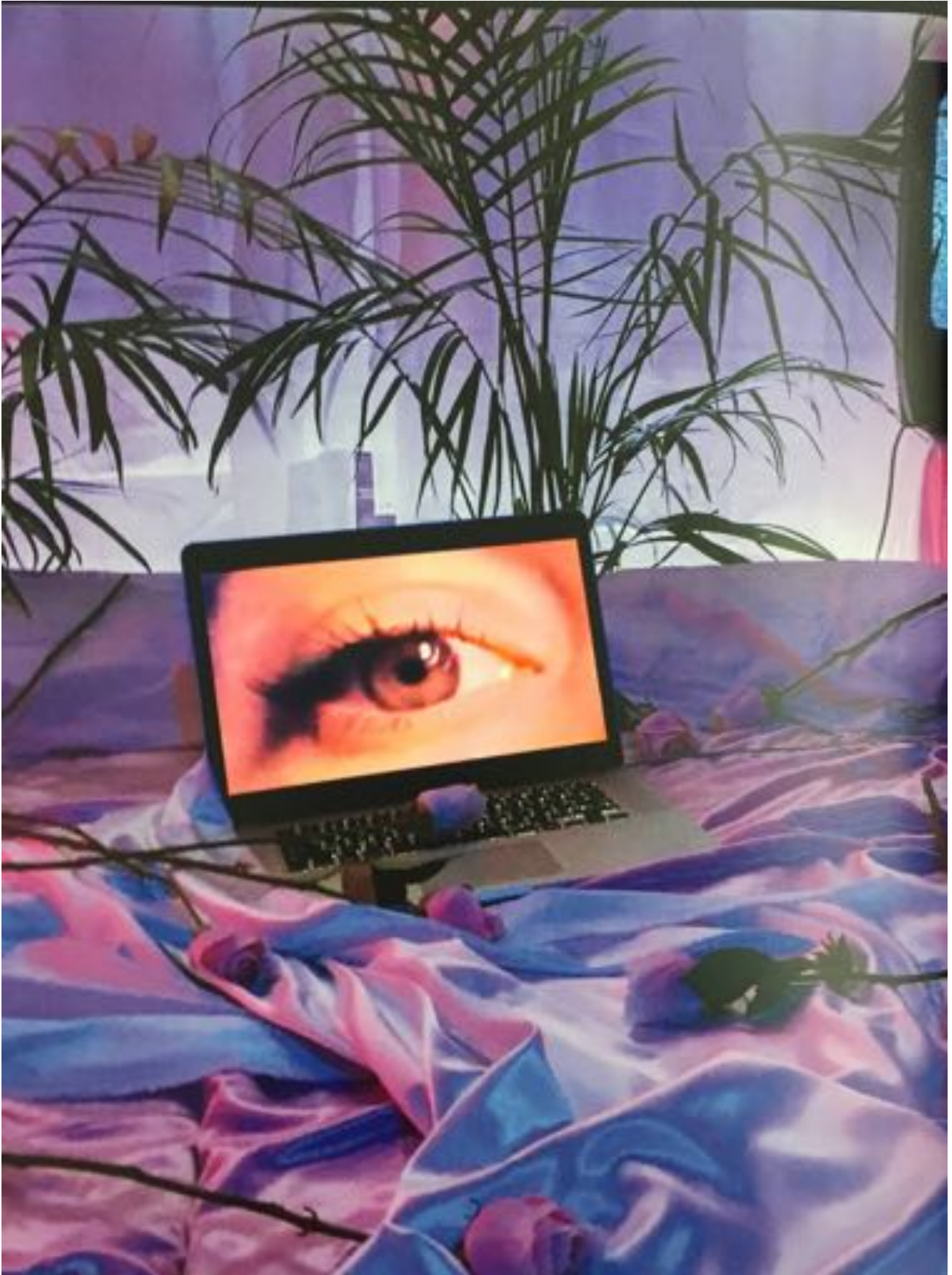


A: What is your biggest source of inspiration?

S: Currently I'm very inspired by Los Angeles. The city functions as one big, living, breathing muse to be consumed. I love the layered narratives and mythologies that surround it-- the way it straddles the lines of heaven and hell, the metaphors that the different locations and areas hold intrinsically. The lush fantasy of the Hills, the suburban banality and sprawl of the Valley, the American dream of Hollywood, the hyper-modern architecture of Downtown, the way that Sunset Boulevard takes you through all of the famous neighbourhoods (Silverlake, Hollywood, Beverly Hills, Bel Air) and dumps you out at the beach near Malibu-- it's just a wonderfully enigmatic place and I can see myself exploring it artistically for years.
